Cancer Care **facility expansion**

As the only accredited cancer center in the area, SSM Health Cancer Care has seen tremendous changes and growth during its 30 years in its existing facility, serving patients from more than 29 counties in Wisconsin. In that time, SSM Health Cancer Care has experienced a significant increase in patients, overall services, and technology.

The \$15 million expansion project planned for the 480 E. Division Street location reaffirms SSM Health's ongoing commitment to comprehensive, local cancer care in the Fond du Lac and surrounding areas.

Highlights of the expansion include:

- A 12,000-square-foot addition, plus remodel of existing areas
- New, welcoming entry, registration area, nourishment space, and family lounges
- Addition of ambulatory infusion services
- Space for four private infusion rooms and 20 semiprivate
- On-site laboratory, pharmacy, physical therapy, massage therapy, boutique and wig fitting room
- Enhanced patient, employee, and provider spaces to accommodate growth
- Healing garden for respite and reflection
- Additional dedicated parking, conveniently located adjacent to facility
