Story of impact

Good Genes, Great Doctors, and the Power of Compassion

Gene Rainbolt often attributed his long life to "good genes." But those who knew him understood there was more to the story - his resilience, his unwavering optimism, and, as he often said, the extraordinary doctors and caregivers who saved his life, not once, but twice.

Born and raised in Oklahoma, Gene built a legacy of leadership and service, Even in his 90s, he remained deeply engaged in his community, working tirelessly to make the state a better place. But despite his strong spirit, there were moments when even his legendary determination wasn't enough - times when expert medical care made all the difference.

The first time was when he fell gravely ill with sepsis while traveling in California. As his condition worsened, Gene knew he needed care from people who truly knew him - doctors who understood his health history, his resilience, and his will to fight. He returned to SSM Health St. Anthony Hospital, where Dr. Gigi Toma and her team intervened just in time, stabilizing his dangerously low blood pressure and saving his life.

Then, in March 2020 at age 91, Gene faced his greatest battle yet. He was diagnosed with COVID-19 at the very beginning of the pandemic, becoming one of the first patients at St. Anthony Hospital to fight the virus. With no proven treatments and an atmosphere of uncertainty and fear, his doctors—Dr. Jeffrey Hirsch, Dr. Randy Allen, and many others - stood by him, navigating uncharted waters to give him the best possible chance of survival.

Alone in his hospital room, struggling to breathe, Gene remembered the moment he considered whether to take another breath or simply let go. But then, Dr. Allen stood by his side, encouraging him: "Breathe in through your nose, out through your mouth." That simple yet powerful support kept Gene fighting. In the days that followed, Dr. Allen even brought him milkshakes from Braum's – a small but meaningful gesture that reminded Gene how much people cared about him.

"The support I got and the help I received gave me the psychological strength to continue to try to improve," Gene recalled.

After weeks of battling the virus, Gene made it home. He described the moment as nothing short of heaven – seeing the sunlight, the trees, the flowers, and feeling the warmth of life once again. But what struck him most was the dedication and bravery of the SSM Health St. Anthony team. The doctors, nurses, and caregivers who risked their own safety to stand by his side weren't just medical professionals; they were heroes.

Gene Rainbolt's life was a testament to resilience, gratitude, and the power of compassionate care. While we lost this legendary leader early this year, his story remains a shining example of the impact that world-class medical care - made possible by donor support - can have on a life.



Community collaborations



Mobile Street Medicine Team SSM Health St. Anthony Hospital and SSM Health

Hospital and SSM Health St. Anthony Foundation have partnered with

the Mental Health Association since the inception of Oklahoma City's first Mobile Street Medicine Team, a transformative initiative designed to provide on-site medical and mental health care to the homeless. In the first six months of 2024, this team served 341 unique individuals and successfully diverted 104 participants from emergency room visits.

Medical Respite Shelter Initiative

As part of our ongoing work to address social determinants of health, SSM Health St. Anthony Hospital is collaborating with SSM Health St. Anthony Foundation and our newest partner, City Care, to support the new Medical Respite Shelter. The shelter will offer an alternative to keeping patients experiencing homelessness in the hospital or discharging them to shelters or the streets. Several hospital leaders are serving on the project task force, and SSM Health Oklahoma is providing funding through our community health initiatives. SSM Health St. Anthony Foundation is also assisting with joint fundraising efforts to help those experiencing homelessness in our communities.

The Medical Respite Shelter will provide an integrated care model, including:

- 24/7 access to a bed and three meals per day
- Transportation to medical appointments
- Access to a phone for telehealth and medical communications
- Secure storage for personal items
- Daily wellness checks and case management for medical/social needs
- Documentation support and housing navigation
- On-site clinical services, chronic condition management, and medication management
- · Behavioral health services
- 24/7 staffing and on-call medical support
- Care coordination with home health providers

This comprehensive model will support patients' recovery and transition to home-based care.

Saints and Stars Program

Oklahoma City University's Kramer School of Nursing partners with SSM Health St. Anthony Hospital and the Foundation through the Saints and Stars program. This partnership aims to address the critical nursing shortage in Oklahoma. The program allows OCU nursing students to

work part-time at St. Anthony Hospital while completing their degree. In addition to the work experience, students receive a \$3,500 annual scholarship from SSM Health St. Anthony Foundation and a \$5,000 annual discount on tuition from OCU.

Beyond the financial benefits, the partnership provides hands-on learning opportunities. Students can participate in clinical rotations, a summer nurse extern program, and paid leadership hours at SSM Health Oklahoma facilities. They'll also be paired with a nurse mentor to guide them.

8th Street Urban Farms

8th Street Urban Farms is an organization that is increasing access to locally grown, healthy produce for those in need in our community. SSM Health St. Anthony Hospital proudly



partners with 8th Street
Urban Farms by contributing
funding and providing
agricultural space on our
Midtown campus. Through
this partnership, we can
supply the fresh, nutritious
produce grown at 8th Street
Urban Farms to families
in need at our SSM Health
Family Medicine Clinic.

Catholic Charities

Catholic Charities has been a long-standing partner of SSM Health St. Anthony Foundation. Through this partnership, the Foundation's Sisters Fund provides prescription medications to those in need. In 2024, 485 individuals received vital, life saving medications thanks to this collaborative effort – medications they may have otherwise gone without.

Reach for the Stars

In 2023, SSM Health St.
Anthony Hospital introduced an exciting new 'Reach for the Stars' scholarship program.
This initiative aims to empower and support employees in pursuing registered nursing degrees by covering the full cost of their nursing education. Given the severe nursing shortage impacting the country, this program couldn't be timelier. In 2024,



36 employees benefitted from this award, and the hospital was excited to celebrate and assist them in achieving their dream of becoming nurses.

At SSM Health St. Anthony Hospital, our employees do more than just carry out the Mission – they fully support it with their gifts. Last year, we celebrated an incredible achievement as our iCare iGive campaign raised a record-breaking \$370,067 – the largest fundraising effort to date.



Help us to move Saints Forward!

For more than 125 years, SSM Health St. Anthony Hospital has provided high-quality care to individuals across Oklahoma City. However, as our patient population grows, our current West Entrance no longer meets the needs of today's patients and visitors. It presents significant barriers, particularly for vulnerable populations such as the elderly, disabled, or those with serious medical conditions. Currently, individuals must cross Lee Avenue, a busy downtown street, contend with unpredictable weather, and navigate stairs and a congested drop-off area.

The new Love Family Entrance will address these challenges by creating a safe, sheltered, and ground-level entrance directly connected to the hospital's existing parking garage. This design will eliminate the need to cross the street, improving safety, especially for individuals with mobility issues.

Our current 3,248-square-foot lobby is insufficient for the volume of patients and families we serve, with over 165,000 patient visits annually. The expanded lobby, at 13,134 square feet, will include dedicated spaces for family gatherings, quiet zones for prayer or reflection, and a peaceful outdoor area with green spaces, walking paths, and seating, providing much needed respite for those in emotional distress.

Tom and Judy Love exemplified decades of dedicated support and visionary leadership for St. Anthony Hospital. Tom's parents, and Margaret Love, were notable volunteers and benefactors. Through their \$5,000,000 lead gift to support the Love Family Entrance, they expressed deep gratitude to the hospital's physicians and caregivers for their exceptional service to their family and many others.
