It's treating the whole person — physically, emotionally, and socially. Taking care of our community holistically is what SSM Health is all about.

Through working alongside our benefactors, health care providers, donors, and more, we can positively affect the lives of those we serve. We hear the stories of gratitude shared with us from people like Tiana, a mother to two daughters and a toddler son.

Tiana's hands were full caring for her little ones and being the main caregiver for her mother. She kept pushing off the pain she felt in her legs because she had too much to do and couldn't take time off for a doctor's appointment. At one point, after several weeks, the pain became unbearable. Tiana was admitted to the emergency room at SSM Health Saint Louis University Hospital for severe pain, swelling, and cramping in her legs.

Our physicians quickly determined blood clots were the source of her problem and posed an immediate threat to her life. Tiana received the specialized care she needed to treat her blocked arteries — along with ongoing support from the SSM Health team. They not only provided education on healthy eating habits but also helped her find a balance between caring for the needs of her family while also taking care of herself.

Our care extends outside the four walls of our hospitals, ensuring our patients have the wraparound support they need to thrive. Combined support helps us:

**Stabilize** the worry and anxiety in our homes with innovative behavioral health care programs.

**Support** the daily experience of individuals through community health initiatives, including food pantries and transportation plans to combat common barriers to care.

**Strengthen** our community and caregivers through education connections and programs.

Our presence in our communities is bright. We know we can shine a light on the opportunities that will positively impact our neighbors, and we are more effective when we work *together*.

# **Story of impact**

### Advancing cutting-edge technology

Providing excellent, compassionate care involves more than advanced educational opportunities and training programs for our caregivers. It also means having access to state-of-the-art medical facilities and equipment for our patient-centered, high-impact programs.

A cancer diagnosis is a shocking and worrisome experience — and patients facing it deserve the highest quality of care and utmost compassion.

Through generous funding from SSM Health
Foundation – St. Louis, the Women's Center at
SSM Health St. Clare Hospital – Fenton has purchased an image-guided upright tomosynthesis
(3D) biopsy table.

This advanced technology dramatically improves biopsy accuracy and reduces the procedure time for patients and health care providers. The new table also eliminates the need to travel from one clinic location to another, as patients receive care in one place at SSM Health St. Clare's Breast Center.

The equipment allows for the targeting of mammogram and 3D-mammogram-only findings that are not visible on an ultrasound. Alongside the state-of-the-art Brevera needle system, the two technologies combine image localization, targeting, breast tissue acquisition, and real-time imaging of the breast tissue.

Our SSM Health Cancer Care efforts – diagnostic testing and research, tailored treatment programs, and more – ensure those living with cancer have the top-notch treatment and care they deserve.

# **Story of impact**

### Providing comprehensive care for women in our region

From preventative care to behavioral health support and beyond, women in our communities need access to specialized care that addresses their unique needs and issues. Too often, we see the women in our lives put their health last while they care for those around them.

Nikki, a single mom with four kids and two jobs, was not prioritizing her type 2 diabetes diagnosis after her car stopped running and she lost her daytime job at the start of the pandemic. Realizing she needed to stop putting her health on the back burner to be the best mom to her little ones, Nikki reached out to SSM Health for help.

Without a car or reliable childcare, Nikki required a doctor's appointment that could work with her schedule. A virtual appointment with SSM Health Women's Wellness Center at SSM Health St. Mary's Hospital - St. Louis was a great starting point to help Nikki get her health back on track. The health care provider helped Nikki get testing supplies and insulin, provided access to patient education for healthy

eating habits, and connected her with long-term resources near her for further assistance.

# **Story of impact**

### Addressing food and nutrition insecurity

In the greater St. Louis region, 1 in 8 struggle with food insecurity and sometimes have to make the impossible choice between paying for food or medical care. The ability to access healthy, nutritious food is just one of the many economic and social conditions that can affect an individual's overall health and well-being.

SSM Health Foundation - St. Louis and SSM Health DePaul Hospital - St. Louis know confronting and overcoming the underlying causes of health issues for the underserved extends outside of treating the symptoms of their health care needs. While our exceptional clinical services make an impact daily, programs like SSM Health DePaul's Bread Basket touch our patients in a way medical care simply cannot.

We work closely with local organizations, like the St. Louis Area Foodbank, to ensure our community members have greater access to the nutrition they need to thrive.

The Bread Basket program at SSM Health DePaul begins when a patient steps through the hospital

doors. They are screened for food insecurity, and if identified as having a need, the health care providers will discharge the patient with two days of food for their household. From there, patients receive connections to the St. Louis Area Foodbank and longer-term community-based support systems, such as SNAP and Medicaid, to help meet their nutritional needs and disrupt the readmission cycle.

By working closely with local organizations, we can ensure our community members have greater access to the nutrients they need to thrive. In 2022, 174 baskets of food were distributed to those who screened positive for food insecurity. In addition to the Bread Basket program, SSM Health offers community-wide food distribution events in partnership with the Foodbank. Also in 2022, we hosted 10 distribution events at our hospitals to feed 6.582 individuals.

Together, we continue to expand this program across other SSM Health hospitals to serve even more in need within the zip codes we serve.

in the program have not been readmitted to the hospital. Reducing readmission rates is an important stabilization measure in health care.


